- Testing APCD-CDL™ data files from DHCS
- Loading and incorporating 2020 Medicare FFS data from CMS
- Developing HPD data request and access regulations (workshop session on 8/10/22 at 10am)


# Progress on Submitter Engagement

- Hosted Submitter Group Meeting July 14
- Holding regular implementation meetings with commercial submitters
- Commercial submitters are in active testing (21 submitters, as of 7/8) to upload historical data to the HPD System
- One submitter is actively submitting production files, more are close to completing testing
- Coordinating with DHCS, Covered CA, and DMHC on the quality and equity measures to include in the HPD analytic dataset
- HCAI/Onpoint teams available for one-on-one submitter meetings

# Implementation – Next Steps

- HCAI and Onpoint teams will continue to meet with submitters as required
- Immediate focus on completing testing and moving to production data collection
- Historical data submissions due by October 28, 2022
- Working with APCD Council and NAHDO on updates to the APCD-CDL™ file format (version 3 to be published in January 2023)
- Enclave procurement by November 2022

# HPD Regulations Packages and Advisory Committee Meetings



- Assumptions / Milestones:
- APM data collection starts in 2025-Q3
  - Will initially collect 3 years of historical APM data
  - Ongoing APM data collection will be an annual process
