### **HPD** Key Deadlines


- Plan registration will take place during the month of January and by the last calendar day of January 2025.
- Submitter registration will take place each year after plan registration has been completed and by the last calendar day of February 2025.
- Dental Data for June 29, 2017 December 2021 due 10/31/2024
- Monthly Dental Submissions begins with November 2024 data due 01/02/2025.
- Dental Data for January 2022 October 2024 due 02/03/2025.

### Data Collection Regulations Reminder

- HPD data collection regulations were certified on November 17, 2023
  - California Code of Regulations Sections 97300-97370
- Regulations will need to be updated with additions of new data collection requirements and/or for each biennial release of the All-Payer Claims Database-Common Data Layout (APCD-CDL)




### HPD Program – Submission Status (2024)

### Data Quality Assurance and Improvement

#### Annual Reports and Plan Engagement Updates

- The reports include:
  - Executive summary
  - Data tables, visuals, summary analyses and questions
    - Completeness Rates for key metrics
    - Unique covered lives count trend analysis.
    - Submission timeliness and Variance requests analyses.
- Data quality team continues to meet with plans to present reports and findings. The aim is to meet with 4 plans each month.
- The data quality team has met with 5 plans to date.



### Data Quality Assurance and Improvement

### NAHDO Data Quality Study

- HCAI is funding a NAHDO data quality study on completion of key metrics by payer breakout
  - Refresh <u>NAHDO's 2019 study</u> with more measures and more State participation (19 States)
  - State comparison of key metrics and establishing benchmarks
  - The report will compare 8 states (including CA) and offer recommendations to improve data quality
- Expected delivery timeline for NAHDO's public report is end of November 2024



## Pharmacy Cost Dashboard

### <u>Pharmacy Cost Dashboard</u>: Fee-For-Service Drug Costs in the Commercial Market

- Launched July 31, 2024
- Allows users to explore various aspects of pharmaceuticals covered by commercial plans in California in 2021; data collected as part of HCAI's HPD program
- Consists of three main topics:
  - Top 25 costliest drug products in terms of total annual statewide spending
  - Top 25 most frequently-prescribed drugs
  - Top 25 drugs with the largest monthly median out-of-pocket cost
- Specifically includes data on fee-for-service retail pharmaceutical claims paid by commercial plans



# Fee-For-Service Drug Costs in the Commercial Market – Key Findings

- Top 25 Costliest Prescription Drugs: The 25 costliest drugs account for just 3.2 percent of all prescriptions in the commercial market but account for nearly 30 percent of total costs at more than \$3.9 billion in 2021.
- Top 25 Most Frequent Prescriptions: The four most frequent prescriptions in the commercial market in 2021 were all COVID-19 vaccines and had zero out-ofpocket costs. The 25 most frequent prescriptions account for 12 percent of all prescriptions and 2.3 percent of total costs at \$297 million.
- Top 25 Out-of-Pocket Costs: The monthly median out-of-pocket cost for the 25 prescription drugs with the highest monthly median out-of-pocket cost ranged from \$150 to \$250 in the commercial insurance market. State policy limits the maximum out-of-pocket cost for the commercial market.

### Analysis Details

- The data presented on the visualizations are from fee-for-service retail pharmaceutical claims paid by commercial plans
  - No medical pharmaceutical costs (on a medical/institutional claim), non-FFS (e.g., capitated) pharmaceutical costs, or costs paid by Medicare or Medi-Cal plan are included
  - Analyses were conducted at the National Drug Code (NDC) level
  - Analyses of total costs and out-of-pocket costs do not include rebates, coupons, or other discounts
- "Cost per Prescription" calculation does not consider the units dispensed for a prescription (e.g., 14-day vs. 30-day supplies) and should be interpreted with caution



# Upcoming: Fee-For-Service Drug Cost Dashboard Update

- An update to the Fee-For-Service Drug Cost Dashboard is underway, aiming for release by the end of the year
- Major changes include:
  - Adding Medi-Cal and Medicare data
  - Adding 2022 data
  - Adding new prescription drug categories for biologics and biosimilars
- New version enables comparisons between different categories
