RE: Seismic Safety Deadline – January 1, 2030

Assembly Bill (AB) 2190 (Chapter 673, Statutes of 2018) granted specified hospitals the opportunity to apply for an extension of the January 1, 2020 seismic compliance deadline. It also required general acute care hospitals with buildings that do not substantially comply with seismic safety standards to attest that their board of directors is aware that the buildings are required to meet the January 1, 2030 compliance deadline.

Hospital buildings that are not rated SPC-4 by December 31, 2029 will no longer be able to house patients overnight or to house essential hospital services. Below is the current status of the four building's on Olympia's campus as of the date of this letter:

Olympia Medical Center - OSHPD # 11863

Building #01 – BLD-00368 – North Wing **SPC-4**
• Surgery, Dietary, Warehouse

Building #02 – BLD-00369 – East Wing **SPC-1**
• Med/Surg, Telemetry, Engineering, Pharmacy, ER

Building #03 – BLD-00370 – West Wing **SPC-2**
• Step-Down Unit, Med/Surg, Offices

Building #04 – BLD-00371 – Pavilion **SPC-2**
• Med/Surg, ICU/CCU, ECT, Administration

Olympia Medical Center has begun the process of upgrading Building #02 to SPC-2 status with a deadline of June 30, 2022. Buildings #02, #03, and #04 can be successfully upgrade to SPC-4 status when funds becomes available.
