RE: AB 2190 Attestation of Commitment to meet 2030 SB499 Compliance Ronald Reagan UCLA Medical Center – 12127

Dear Mr. Scheuerman,

This letter is in response to your correspondence to Ms. Johnese Spisso, CEO, dated July 23, 2019, requesting attestation of UCLA Health's commitment to comply with provisions of Assembly Bill 2190. UCLA Health, under the direction and authority of our Governing Board, plans to complete the following:

CURRENT STATUS

The Ronald Reagan UCLA Medical Center, OSHPD BLD-02895, is currently SPC5 and NPC4. The Campus also consists of our Central Plant, also known as the Emergency Services Building, OSHPD BLD-02926. The entire facility was also constructed with water and waste storage to allow for continuous operation for a 72 hour period, allowing the entire facility to meet an NPC5 rating in January 2030, when the new Central Plant is in operation.

PLANS FOR IMPROVEMENT

UCLA Health intends to remove the required services and functions currently provided by the Emergency Services Building, (OSHPD BLD-02926) and replace them with a new dedicated Central Plant Building to serve the RRUMC. This project is in progress with an anticipated completion date of 2028.

CONCLUSION

The addition of this new dedicated Central Plant to the Facility and the corresponding removal of the current Emergency Services Building will enable the RRUMC Facility to achieve a SPC5, NPC5 Seismic Performance Rating, as required by provisions of Assembly Bill 2190, before the January 1, 2030 deadline.
