To Whom It May Concern:

I write this letter as required by the State of California, Health and Safety Code, Section 130066. As a representative of the board of directors for the USC Verdugo Hills Hospital, an acute care inpatient hospital, I acknowledge the current seismic compliance status of the buildings on this hospital campus reflected in the chart below.

I also acknowledge that all hospital buildings on this campus are required to meet the January 1, 2030 deadline for substantial compliance with those regulations and standards.

The West Addition is SPC-4 and thus has already met the January 1, 2030 Structural compliance deadline. The East Addition is still identified as SPC-3s (s indicates "self-declared") and is expected to meet the January 1, 2030 Structural compliance deadline pending OSHPD's review and concurrence of the self-declared rating of SPC-3.



By January 1, 2030, both the Main Building North Tower and South tower will be required to

- Be retrofitted to SPC-4D compliance or
- Be decommission by removing all acute services from these buildings or
- Be demolished

In addition, since the four listed acute care buildings on this campus are currently NPC-2, each building is required to be NPC-4D compliant by January 1, 2030 and the entire hospital campus is required to be NPC-5 compliant by January 1, 2030.
