Teaching Health Centers (THC)	<ul> <li>\$170,000 per filled first year slot</li> </ul>
	No maximum on slots
	<ul> <li>One year grant to support a recognized THC</li> </ul>
Expansion Slots	\$300,000 per filled first year slot
	Maximum of three slots
	<ul> <li>Three year grant to support at least one resident of a PCR program that has permanently expanded</li> </ul>
New Programs	• Up to \$800,000
	<ul> <li>One year grant to offset the costs associated with achieving ACGME or AOA accreditation</li> </ul>

## New Programs Funding: Considerations

- Six programs qualified for funding by receiving at least 50 percent of total points (61.5).
- Total funding available is \$6,186,958.
- Need \$4,800,000 to fund all eligible programs:
  - General Fund base funding: \$3,333,000
  - General Fund rollover: \$2,853,958
- Leaves \$1,386,958 to rollover to next year.
- We cannot use remaining funds for other funding categories.

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# Existing Slots Funding: Considerations

- Seventy programs qualified for funding by receiving at least 50 percent of total points (57.5).
- Commission may consider funding all qualifying programs using the approved funding methodology.
- Total funding allocation would be \$20,375,000:
  - General fund base funding: \$18,667,000
  - General Fund rollover: \$1,695,451
  - Data Fund: \$12,549



# Expansion Slots Funding: Considerations

- Thirteen programs qualified for funding by receiving at least 50 percent of total points (57.5).
- Commission can provide some funding to all qualifying programs.
- Commission may consider :
  - Reducing award to one slot for programs scoring below 65 points.
    - Funds 22 expansion slots.
- Commission may consider:
  - Awarding all 25 expansion slots.



#### **Expansion Slots Funding: Considerations**

• Total allocation to fund 22 expansion slots: \$6,600,000:

## THC Slots Funding: Considerations

- All eight programs qualified for funding by receiving at least 50 percent of total points (57.5).
- Increased demand for THC funds: 8 programs applied for 61 slots. Insufficient funding to award all 61 slots.
- Commission may consider limiting funding for each program to ten slots.
  - Two programs asked for >10 slots.
  - Fund remaining requested slots.
  - Total slots funded: 54
  - Assumes funding is provided for 22 expansion slots.
- Commission may consider fully funding the top tier and limiting funding to seven slots for all other programs.
  - Three programs asked for >7 slots.
  - Fund remaining requested slots.
  - Total slots funded: 48
  - Assumes funding is provided for 25 expansion slots.
