Background

- OSHPD staff conducted two stakeholder meetings, November and December of 2016, to collect input to determine presenter selection criteria.
- OSHPD staff presented the Commission with an analysis and recommendations to determine PCR presentation selection criteria at the January 2017 FNP/PA Funding Meeting.
- The Commission approved staff's recommendation to focus presentations on innovation in career pathways and pipeline programs.



Considerations

- Continue presentation focus on innovation in career pathways and pipeline programs.
- Choose another presentation focus. Previously suggested topics:
 - Program Demographics: underrepresented minorities and/or economically disadvantaged groups.
 - Locations: rural, urban, frontier, medically underserved, multicultural communities (under-represented minorities) lower socioeconomic neighborhoods, ambulatory and community settings.
 - Program Structure/Design: inter-disciplinary teams, curriculum, outreach efforts, challenges/success, best practices, teaching, modalities.
