Elizabeth Landsberg

Elizabeth Landsberg is the Director of the Department of Healthcare Access and Information (HCAI). Previously she was a Deputy Director at the Department of Managed Health Care (DMHC) overseeing the Help Center which assists consumers and providers with health care complaints. Before joining DMHC, Landsberg was an advocate for health care consumers in the nonprofit realm for more than 16 years. She was the Director of Policy Advocacy for the Western Center on Law & Poverty where she specialized in health care issues including health reform implementation, Medi-Cal, Covered California, and other issues affecting poor Californians. Earlier in her career, Landsberg was the Supervising Attorney for the Health Rights Hotline at Legal Services of Northern California. She was a Ruth Chance Law Fellow at Equal Rights Advocates and served as a law clerk to Federal District Court Judge Martha Vázquez. Landsberg received her law degree from UC Berkeley where she was the Editor-in-Chief of the *Berkeley Women's Law Journal*. She holds a bachelor's in history from Pomona College.
