HCAI Policy Intent Notice (PIN) 72 clarifies the process for which facilities will need to follow when requesting Emergency Authorization to Proceed (EAP) for the projects that require immediate remediation in order to keep Health Care Facilities functional to serve and protect patient care services in the physical environment.

This webinar focuses on what is required to request an EAP and how to complete an application through eCA to initiate the review process.

- Understand the process of submitting an EAP per PIN 72.
- Clarify the different types of EAP projects.
- Establish clear expectations for all project participants on the EAP.
