**PURPOSE**

This Code Application Notice (CAN) clarifies the application and enforcement of the California Building Standards Code, Title 24 of the California Code of Regulations (Title 24), including revisions to the code, for projects submitted to the Office of Statewide Hospital Planning and Development (OSHPD or the Office) to ensure consistent application and enforcement.

**BACKGROUND**

OSHPD is authorized to enforce Title 24 for hospital and skilled nursing construction projects. The Office provides plan review and construction observation of the design and specifications for the architectural, structural, mechanical, plumbing, electrical, and fire and life safety components of these

health care facilities. Projects submitted to OSHPD for review must be compliant with the requirements of all parts of Title 24 that are effective at the time a new project is accepted for plan review.

This CAN clarifies the code application of Title 24 that OSHPD will enforce to ensure consistency throughout the duration of the project through to completion.

## **APPLICATION**

OSHPD shall use the edition of Title 24 including supplements that are in effect at the time the ***Application for New Project*** is deemed complete and accepted for plan review.

A new project application must be created through the HCAI [eServices Portal \(eSP\)](#). eServices user accounts are available to anyone upon registration as appropriate permissions are required to view and upload documents to project records. Please see the [eSP User Guide: Applications for New Projects](#) and the [HCAI website](#) for additional information, links, and instructions.

Title 24, Part 1, Section 7-113, Application for plan, report, or seismic compliance extension review, requires that before commencing construction or alteration of any health facility, the governing board or authority shall apply for plan review to the Office and shall obtain the written approval by the Office describing the scope of work included and any special conditions under which approval is given.

Application Specific Information – Plan Review: This section of the application asks for “Submittal Type” from the following options:

- Preliminary Review (Architectural and Fire and Life Safety Preliminary Plans and Annotated Specifications)
- Final Review (100% Construction Documents and Reports)
- Geotechnical/Geohazard Only Review (Geotechnical Report review by Engineering Geologist)
- Integrated Review (Projects over \$20 million)
- Examination (Clinics and other projects reviewed on a time and material fee basis)
- Senate Bill (SB) 1838 – Projects of \$50,000 or less (exempt from plan review)

Submitting Documents for Review: All construction documents and reports shall be uploaded to the eServices Portal and shall be permitted to be submitted in three consecutive stages.

- Title 24, Part 1, Section 7-117 Site data. The site data reports (Geotechnical/Geohazard Reports) shall be furnished to the Office for review and evaluation prior to the submittal of the project documents for final plan review. Site data reports shall comply with the requirements of these regulations and the California Building Standards Code. Upon the determination that the investigation of the site and the reporting of the findings was adequate for the design of the project, the Office will issue a letter stating the site data reports are acceptable.
- Title 24, Part 1, Section 7-123, Preliminary plans and annotated specifications may be submitted for review prior to submittal of the final construction documents.

If you have submitted an application for Preliminary Review and final construction documents are not submitted to the Office within one year of the date of the Office’s report on preliminary



**TITLE 24 Triennial Edition**

By law, Title 24 is adopted by the California Building Standards Commission during the Commission's Triennial Code Adoption Cycle and published in its entirety every three years. It contains the most recent model codes with the incorporation of California amendments promulgated by OSHPD and other authorized state agencies. Title 24 consists of 12 parts and OSHPD enforces the requirements of the following seven parts: Part 1, California Administrative Code; Part 2, California Building Code; Part 3, California Electrical Code; Part 4, California Mechanical Code; Part 5, California Plumbing Code; Part 6, California Energy Code; Part 7, California Wildland-Urban Interface Code; Part 9, California Fire Code; Part 10, California Existing Building Code and Part 11, California Green Building Standards Code.

The triennial edition of the Title 24 becomes effective 180 days after the publication date unless otherwise stipulated. The effective date is indicated on the front page of the code book for each part of Title 24 and is also printed in the "History Note Appendix" in the back of the code book. The California Administrative Code, Part 1 of Title 24, is effective 30 days after filing with the Secretary of State and is printed in the "History Note Appendix" for each chapter of Part 1, CAC.

Project applications and plans submitted to OSHPD on or after the effective date of the triennial edition of the code will be reviewed under that new code. All plans submitted and/or processed after the effective date of a new code shall be reviewed under that code. An exception, however, may be made for projects submitted prior to the effective date of a triennial code but who want the project reviewed under the newer code. The applicant may request that the project be reviewed by OSHPD under the newly adopted triennial code. The request must be in writing and must be submitted with the project application. If the request is granted, all parts of that edition of Title 24 will be applied to the project. The project will be reviewed under all applicable codes as if it had been submitted on or after the effective date of that edition.

**TITLE 24 Supplements**

Amendments, adoptions, and repeals to the triennial edition of the Title 24 are adopted in a subsequent code adoption cycle that is offset 18 months from the triennial cycle. These code changes are published in supplements and include symbols such as bars, carets and arrows in the margins to distinguish the revisions to the triennial code. Reviewers shall update the Title 24 code books as the supplements are received and retain the previous language to ensure the correct codes will be applied and enforced relative to the date the *Application for New Project* was accepted for plan review.

The regulations contained in these supplements are effective 180 days after their publication date unless otherwise stipulated. The exception is the California Administrative Code which goes into effect 30 days after filing with the Secretary of State. This information can be found in the "History Note Appendix" of the code supplement. The most recent California Administrative Code changes went into effect April 6, 2025.

Projects shall be reviewed under the edition of Title 24 and all the supplements that are in effect at the time the project application is received by OSHPD. At no time will selective application of code revisions contained in the supplements be applied to a project. If the supplement is applied to the project, all the revisions contained in the supplement edition will be applied. Project plans will not be reviewed under supplements prior to their effective date unless a specific request is granted by the

Information is added regarding the *Application for New Project* using the HCAI eServices Portal, as well as the documents, plans, specifications, reports, etc., that are required for plan review.

The process is outlined and shows the steps that both the applicant and OSHPD will take to determine when a new project application is deemed complete and accepted for plan review, thereby locking in the effective date of the edition of Title 24 that will be enforced for that project.
