Education and Training Programs

- Song-Brown Healthcare Workforce Training
 - Funds new, expansion, existing, and Teaching Health Center residency programs in Primary Care (Family Medicine, Internal Medicine, Obstetrics/Gynecology, and Pediatrics)
- Train New Trainers Primary Care Psychiatry Fellowship Scholarship
 - Provides funding to train primary care physicians in primary care psychiatry
- Psychiatric Education Capacity Expansion (PECE) Grant Program
 - Funds new psychiatry residency programs, new child/adolescent psychiatry fellowships, new addiction fellowships, and the expansion of existing psychiatry, child/adolescent, and addiction fellowships
- Addiction Medicine Fellowships
 - Funds new or expansion addiction medicine fellowships
- California Reproductive Health Service Corps Initiative
 - Supports targeted recruitment and retention resources and financial support for reproductive services training

Recruitment and Retention Programs

▪ Loan Repayment Programs

- County Medical Services (CMSP) Loan Repayment Program
 - Family Medicine, General Internal Medicine, General Psychiatrists, Obstetrics/Gynecology
 - California State Loan Repayment Program
 - Physicians (MD/DO)
- Steven M. Thompson Physician Corps Loan Repayment Program
 - Physicians or Surgeons (primary care, specialist)

▪ Conrad 30 J-1 Visa Waiver Program

- Foreign educated physicians completing their residency in the U.S. may apply for one of 30 waivers to remain in the U.S. and provide direct patient care to underserved communities and populations in California

Health Professions Career Opportunity Program

- Health Professions Pathways Program

- Provides funding to organizations to develop and implement health professions pathways programs that can include pipeline programs, summer internships, and post undergraduate fellowships with a focus on programs designed to recruit and support students from underrepresented regions and backgrounds.

- Health Careers Exploration Program

- Provides funding to organizations to strengthen educational and social foundations by providing direct and indirect program support for underrepresented and/or disadvantaged individuals interested in pursuing healthcare careers.

GME and Primary Care Appropriations

■ 2022 – 2023

- Song-Brown primary care residency program: \$43M
- Addiction Psychiatry and Addiction Medicine Fellowship Grants: \$25M
- Clinical Infrastructure: Reproductive Health Care Loan Repayment and Scholarships: \$20M
- California Reproductive Healthcare Service Corps: \$20M
- HPCOP: E-Cigarette Excise Tax: Approximately \$1.5M (ongoing, amount depends on tax revenue)

■ 2021 – 2022

- Health Professions Career Opportunity Program: \$16M (ongoing)
- Song-Brown Healthcare Workforce Training Programs to support new primary care residency programs: \$50M
- Geriatric Care Workforce: \$8M
