


## **REGISTERED DENTAL HYGIENISTS**

## REGISTERED DENTAL HYGIENISTS

Registered Dental Hygienists (RDH) remove plaque and clean and polish teeth using scaling instruments and a rotating polisher. They apply decay preventative agents such as fluorides and sealants, chart medical and dental histories, and take and develop dental x-ray films. They also screen patients, take a medical history, and add information to the patient's chart.
