  - Delay in compliance Clarify Seismic Design Category (SDC) F Non-Structural Performance Category (NPC) deadlines.
  - NPC evaluation deadlines and requirements for buildings removed from service.

  - Deletion of language related to past Structural Performance Category (SPC)-1 extensions.

  - Delete the exception of five pounds per foot for distribution systems.

- Requirement for design criteria and peer review/witness when wind tunnel tests are used in lieu of ASCE 7 wind design loads.
- o Add criteria for use of aluminum ceilings in MRI rooms.
- Add requirements for operation of elevator switches that get tripped post seismic event.
- Chapter 19/19A:
  - Tension testing of screw anchors when these anchors resist only shear loads.
  - Additional requirements for concrete strengthening by externally bonded fiber reinforced polymer (FRP)
