- Train New Trainer (TNT) Primary Care Psychiatry Fellowship Scholarship
 - Year-long program for primary care providers to receive advanced training in primary care
 psychiatry
 - Scholarship application open now: <u>PCP TNT Scholarship Application</u>
 - Closes October 27, 2023
- Train New Trainers (TNT) Primary Care Training and Education in Addiction Medicine
 - Year-long program for primary care providers to receive training on the most frequently encountered pain and addiction-related disorders and treatments
 - Scholarship application open now: <u>PC-Team Scholarship</u>
 - Application closes November 30, 2023



- Peer Personnel Training and Placement Program
 - Recruits, trains, certifies, and places peer personnel to serve in public behavioral health and community-based settings
 - Made 16 awards totaling \$14.5M for the Peer 23-24 cycle in June 2023.
 - Awardees projected to train 3,300 Peer Participants



- Health Professions Pathways Program (HPPP)
 - Provides funding to organizations to recruit and support students from underrepresented regions and backgrounds. Program components can include:
 - Pipeline programs
 - Internships
 - Post undergraduate fellowships

Justice System-Involved Youth Behavioral Health Pipeline

- Funds organizations that encourage students to pursue careers in Behavorial Health
- Applications open now: <u>JSIY and HPPP Application</u>
 - Application closes October 16, 2023



- Caring4Cal
 - Application closed August 11, 2023
 - \$25M fund seeks to expand, enhance, and strengthen California's Home and Community-Based Services healthcare workforce
 - 60 applications were received, requesting just under \$73M in funding. Grantees will be selected in September/October



Workforce Programs Update <u>Recruitment and Retention Programs</u>

- Advanced Practice Healthcare Scholarship Program
 - Increases the number healthcare professionals providing direct patient care in California.
 - Scholarship application open now: <u>APHSP Application</u>
 - Application closes October 31, 2023
- Allied Healthcare Scholarship Program
 - Increases the number of allied healthcare professionals providing direct patient care in California.
 - Scholarship application open now: <u>AHSP Application</u>
 - Application closes October 31, 2023



Workforce Programs Update Recruitment and Retention Programs

- Nursing Scholarship Programs
 - Increase the number of nurses providing direct patient care in California
 - Scholarship applications open now:
 - Associates Degree in Nursing <u>Application</u>
 - Bachelor's Degree in Nursing <u>Application</u>
 - LVN to ADN <u>Application</u>
 - Vocational Nursing <u>Application</u>



Community Health Workers, Promotoras(es) and Representatives (CHW/P/R)

- Updates since June meeting:
 - <u>Guidance letter</u> published on July 1st
 - Continued stakeholder engagement
 - Next phase Fall 2023:
 - Finalize training program application process
 - Open the training program application cycle



Reproductive Health Access Initiative

Capitol Infrastructure

- HCAI partnered with the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services (Cal OES) to administer a grant program to provide security enhancements to facilities providing abortion and reproductive health care.
- First Request For Proposal resulted in grants awarded in May 2023, totaling \$8.2M to 21 health care facilities
- Uncompensated Care and Abortion Practical Support Funds
 - HCAI contracted with Essential Access Health to administer the Uncompensated Care
 and Abortion Practical Support grant programs
 - Uncompensated Care Grants totaled \$20.7M to 12 health care providers and Abortion Practical Support grants totaled \$5M to 16 nonprofit organizations were announced in July 2023.



Update on Funding Delays:

- The FY 2023-24 Budget reinstated proposed delays in workforce funding including the following:
 - Nursing Initiative -- \$70 million
 - CHW/P/R-- \$15 million
 - Song-Brown Nurses -- \$15 million
 - Addiction Psychiatric/Medicine Fellowships -- \$48.5 million
 - College grants to behavioral health professionals-- \$52 million
 - Expand Master of Social Work (MSW) slots at public MSW programs -- \$30 million
