## Drawing Lots for Initial Committee Terms

#### Section 127376 (b)(1):

- The initial terms of the committee members shall be established to create staggered terms of office by drawing lots at the first meeting of the committee.
- One-half of the committee members shall serve a two-year term, and one-half of the committee members shall serve a one-year term.
- After their initial term of office is complete, a committee member shall serve a two-year term.





# Ground Rules – Hybrid Meeting

- All voting committee members are participating in person at the Sacramento or Los Angeles offices
- Members of the public can participate in person or virtually and provide public comment via either platform

- Serve as a link between your organization, constituents, and the Health Care Equity Measures Advisory Committee to provide stakeholder perspectives.
- Support Committee outreach efforts to raise awareness about the Hospital Equity Reporting Program.
- Attend and actively participate in all committee meetings. There will be no delegates, substitutes, or proxies for meetings.
