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# The HPD Story...

**Before 2018**

Years of deliberation among policymakers and various attempts to establish an All-Payer Claims Database in California, inspired by the success of other states in establishing their own APCDs.

**2018 - 2020**

2018-19 budget bill provided \$60m start-up funding and directed HCAI to convene a committee of stakeholders and experts to develop a report for how to build an APCD.

Convened stakeholder committee and submitted report to the Legislature in March 2020.

2020-21 budget bill provided additional enabling legislation that formally required health plans and insurers to submit data and authorized HCAI to develop the database.

**2021 - 2022**

Engaged data submitters and other partners, including NAHDO to adopt the APCD-CDL format.

Develop database technology infrastructure and begin data collection.

Convene Data Release Committee.

**2023 - 2024+**

**Substantially complete the database.**

Begin producing public reports and analytical files.

Begin accepting applications for non-public research data.

Develop long-term funding model.

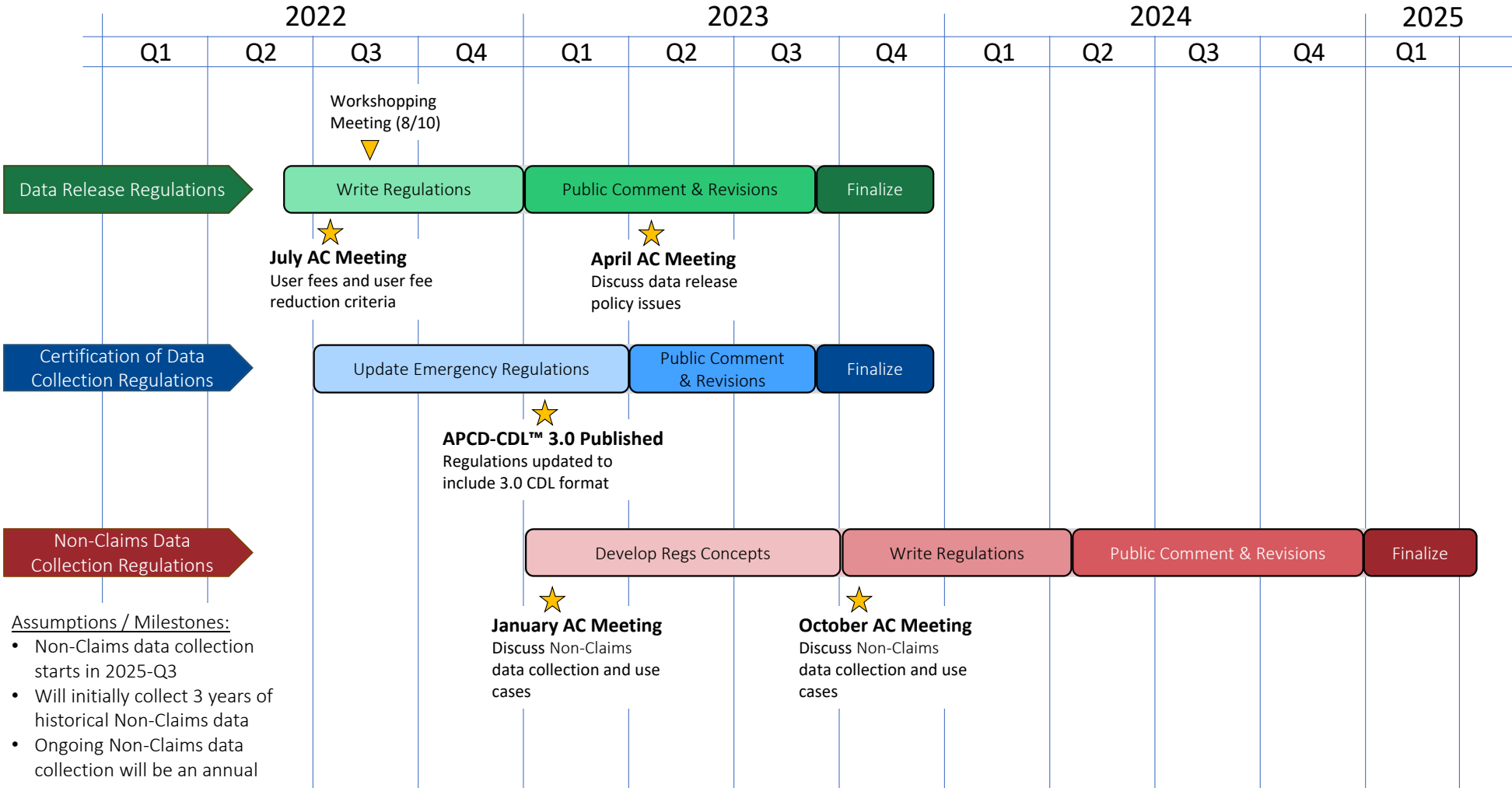
# HPD Implementation Update

- HPD Program continues to be focused on data collection, producing the analytic dataset, and initial public reporting
- Data Enclave module development is on track for Q1 2024 go-live
- DHCS data successfully processed through March 2023
- 2018-2021 Medicare FFS data acquired from CMS; 2021 data came in after HPD Snapshot Public Report
- Standard limited dataset design progressing
- HPD data request and access regulations completed public comment 07/18/2023

# Implementation – Next Steps

- Continued Submitter engagement
  - Hosted Submitter Group Meeting July 13
  - Dental Plan outreach meeting held July 20
  - HCAI and Onpoint teams continue to meet with submitters
  - Monthly production submissions ongoing
- APCD-CDL™ version 3.0.1 transition plan ongoing
- Developing federal funding update for 2025, and CMS system certification for enhanced funding during ongoing operations
- Developing data release program to receive access requests in Q1 2024

- Assumptions / Milestones:
- Non-Claims data collection starts in 2025-Q3
  - Will initially collect 3 years of historical Non-Claims data
  - Ongoing Non-Claims data collection will be an annual process
