Q&A Session

Q: I just had a question looking at the NCP data layout file. In the technical specifications, there is a paragraph that says the guidance is intentionally silent on establishing the definition for primary care and behavioral health so I wanted to follow up.

A: The HPD program does not have an officially adopted definition. The Office of Healthcare Affordability (OHCA) has created a Primary Care code set which is available as an optional resource in the HPD Reporting Manual for plans to utilize. OHCA is currently developing a Behavioral Health Code Set that we are also planning to offer as an optional resource once finalized. We are aware that that is a point of question for a lot of people, and we expect to provide additional guidance in Summer 2026.

Q: You have a slide about California non-residents, would that mean for date of service they would be a non-resident? We are not talking about once they move.

A: Residency is assessed at date of service. If the member was a resident of California at the date of service, we would expect to receive that data.

Q: NDC Product Code, should I submit 9-digit or 11-digit NDC Product Code?

A: Currently, both formats are acceptable, but the 11-digit format is preferred for more accurate pharmacy file submissions. Once regulations are approved and we transition to APCD CDL v4.0.1, submitters will be required to use the 11-digit format.
