



Frequently Asked Questions

Who participates in the program?

California's larger hospitals report each year – those with operating costs of \$50 million or more, or \$25 million or more if they're part of a hospital system.

How often does the Commission meet?

Three public meetings each year, typically held in May, August, and November.

Can the public attend the HSDC meetings?

Yes. All meetings are open to the public and held in a hybrid format – attend in person in Sacramento or online.

What is the HSD Reporting Program?

When hospitals buy from diverse businesses, local economies grow stronger. Hospitals are some of the biggest employers and buyers in the communities they serve. When they work with more diverse businesses, they help those businesses grow – building stronger supply chains.

The HSD Reporting Program collects and shares information about hospital supplier diversity efforts across California.



What is the Hospital Supplier Diversity Commission?

The Hospital Supplier Diversity Commission (HSDC) advises the Department of Health Care Access and Information (HCAI) and the hospital industry on ways to increase engagement with diverse suppliers. The HSDC:

- Provides recommendations to improve supplier diversity
- Shares what works best
- Promotes outreach and education
- Supports hospitals doing this work
