



Increasing Diversity & Transparency

Mandatory Tier II Reporting

In August 2018, Vizient was the <u>first</u> Group Purchasing Organization (GPO) to <u>contractually</u> require all Tier I suppliers to report their Tier II spend with diverse suppliers, contractors and subcontractors quarterly.

This supports our providers to find suppliers that meet their quality, cost and diversity criteria — and to make more informed decisions based on the net impact of their sourcing decisions across these two layers of the supply chain.



Growth & Development

Preparing and supporting providers, Prime suppliers, and diverse suppliers to deliver value in the healthcare industry through:

- Identifying and disseminating best practices
- Mentor/protégé programs in collaboration with providers, large suppliers and in Tier II initiatives
- Offering educational tools, guidance and support
- Input from Supplier Diversity Advisory Council (member focused)
- Engagement and visibility of diverse suppliers with provider supply chain decision makers



Capacity Building

Inner City Capital Connections (ICCC)

- Vizient is partnered with ICCC to provide learning and potential access to capital for diverse suppliers in 14 markets nationwide.
- Created to ensure inner city businesses achieve success, thrive and support their local economies. The ICCC model is based on 4 C's – Capital, Connections, Capacity-Building, and Coaching.
- Through Vizient's partnership with ICCC, members have an opportunity to participate which helps with the growth and development of their business.

Community Contracting Program

Investing in local markets and communities

Community Contracting Program facilitates reinvesting in the local economy using the power of purchasing within healthcare systems by directing spend to local, diverse suppliers who in turn hire from the community providing livable wages, insurance, and career paths. By engaging all hospitals in a region as well as large suppliers, who through Community Contracting Program contracts with local, diverse suppliers, creates a socially and economically sustainable ecosystem resulting in healthier populations.



Stories of Impact

Ethnic Care & Skin Care

Last year to help hospitals better welcome and care for diverse patient populations, Vizient launched a new Ethnic Hair and Skin Care category enabling members to select products designed for African American, Hispanic-American, Asian, and Native American patients.

When it came to contracting, we engaged certified diverse suppliers to manufacture and distribute this new line.

As a result, a diverse supplier in California, manufacturing ethnic skin and hair care products now has an opportunity to expand its business into the healthcare space.



Stories of Impact

Office Supplies

In 2019 Vizient's Supplier Diversity team collaborated with Purchase Services with a focus on increasing supplier diversity opportunities and spend within the Vizient services space.

When it came to contracting, we leveraged Vizient's GPO agreement with a certified minority-owned supplier.

As a result, through execution of the agreement and were able to reduce costs up to 15% on average. The diverse supplier was recognized as Supplier of the Year by Vizient and as then recognized as a high-performing business they were named National Supplier of the Year by a national diversity organization.
