WSMC and SFHC plan to merge, with WSMC as the surviving entity. This transaction is intended to secure the financial viability of SFHC, which might otherwise close. The parties do not anticipate any adverse impacts of the transaction on the public.

Description of current services provided and expected post-transaction impacts on health care services	SFMC is a non-profit FQHC that provides comprehensive healthcare and supportive services to residents at 4 sites in northeastern

rural California, namely Nevada and Yuba Counties.

In 2023 SFMC served 2,048 patients, of all ages, genders, races, ethnicities, and disability statuses. SFMC's clinics primarily provide services in English. Of the total patients served in 2023 there were 1,662 in Nevada County, 18 in Sierra County, 363 in Yuba County and 5 unknown. Currently SFHC has 35 employees and 3 contractors. SFMC provides medical, dental, chiropractic, and behavioral health services. There are no anticipated changes to staffing levels, services, or locations. The community needs assessment shows a need for primary and pediatric care; women's and maternal care; dental care; behavioral health care services; substance use disorder services; case management; and specialty services, such as cardiology, podiatry, and chiropractic; all of which are offered at WSMC and will be shared resources at all sites of service. Both organizations currently offer, and will continue to offer post-transaction, a sliding fee discount program that allows for self-declaration if an individual is without an income. These individuals are eligible for waived fees once the application is completed. All sites of service are open to Medi-Cal and Medicare patients, and will continue to be posttransaction.

There is one health care entity within 20 miles, which is an Indian health center offering similar services to those of the merging organizations.
