Agenda Item 4: Hospital Supplier Diversity Reporting Program Update

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Program Overview

- HSD Fact Sheet
- Each licensed hospital with operating expenses of fifty million dollars (\$50,000,000) or more, and each licensed hospital with operating expenses of twenty-five million dollars (\$25,000,000) or more that is part of a hospital system, shall submit a report to HCAI.
- Supplier Diversity Reports consist of a series of questions surrounding the hospital's procurement efforts and processes.
- We collect a hospital spend data from business enterprises <u>that employ the majority of their workforce in</u> <u>California and meet the definition of women-owned, minority-owned, disabled veteran-owned and/or LGBT-owned business enterprise</u> as defined in California Code of Regulations, Title 22, Chapter 8, Section 95000.
- Report data to the extent the data is available.
- A one time, 30-day extension is allowed (per reporting period).



2023 Reporting Year Recap

	Challenges Identified:	Establishing contact with some hospitals. Delayed responses from hospitals. Hospital acquisitions.
	Data entry errors identified:	Incorrect procurement spend data reported due to typo. System procurement spend data submitted as individual hospital spend data.
N	Data improvements:	2023 Revisions submitted for both individual and system reports. Submitters are more familiar with submission process and reporting requirements. Improved data collected in 2023.

- Total number of hospitals required to submit: 347
- Voluntary submissions: 24

AB 1392 Reporting Changes

AB 1392 Reporting Impact

Expands the Hospital Supplier Diversity report to include:

- Rephrases current questions and adds additional questions surrounding:
 - Short-term and long-term goals and timetables for increasing procurement from diverse business enterprises. (not quotas)
 - Methods in which hospitals resolve any issues that may limit or impede an enterprise from becoming a supplier.
 - Information on appropriation contacts for interested business enterprises and description of the procurement process.
 - Planned and past implementation of relevant recommendations made by the Hospital Supplier Diversity Commission.

First reports to include this information is for the 2024 report period due July 1, 2025.
