Status of Public Reporting on Specific Topic Priorities

- Health Equity (see next slide)
- Enhancement of Prescription Drug Costs report
 - Enhancements include expansion beyond commercial payers and two years of data
- Reporting on Hospital Costs
 - Late stage of development. Discussed key decision points in July HPD Advisory Committee meeting.
- Primary Care
 - Early/mid-stage development of HPD dashboard on primary care utilization, travel distance, and continuity of care.

Health Equity Update

- Healthy Places Index (HPI)
 - The Public Health Institute's pricing structure has changed, and HCAI is seeking a solution that will allow continued use of HPI.
- Race/Ethnicity
 - Data completeness is low, which prevents reporting right now
 - Planned multi-step process to impute missing values
 - Determine acceptability of reporting imputed data based on this method

Discussion Question: Does the Advisory Committee have input on these 2026 priorities?

Dental Data

- HCAI does not yet have a full year of production data collected and processed for analysis
- Public reporting on dental topics is likely to begin in 2027 at the earliest
- Dental reporting will depend on available resources and the relative priority of dental compared with other topics
