Application Evaluation Criteria

- During the application evaluation process, Song-Brown uses a two part methodology to evaluate four criteria.
 - I.1 Percent and number of clinical training sites in medically underserved areas.
 - I.2 Percent and number of underrepresented minority graduates.
 - I.3 Percent and number of graduates in medically underserved areas.
 - II.2 Percent and number of graduates in primary care ambulatory settings five years' post residency.

Application Evaluation Criteria: Scoring Methodology Part 1: Percentage

- Scoring Methodology Part 1: Predetermined point system.
 - The range of percentages the program falls within determines points for Percentage.

Sections I.1, I.2, and I.3

Percentage	Points
<1%	0
1-16 %	2
17-33%	4
34-50.99%	6
51-67.99%	8
68-84.99%	10
85-100%	12

Section II.2

Percentage	Points
<1%	0
1-16.99 %	1.5
17-33.99%	3
34-50.99%	4.5
51-67.99%	6
68-84.99%	7.5
85-100%	9

Application Evaluation Criteria: Scoring Methodology Part 1: Example

Program X Example

- The program has 58 percent underrepresented minority graduates.
- The percentage methodology shows that the program will receive 8 points.

Sections I.1, I.2, and I.3

Percentage	Points
<1%	0
1-16 %	2
17-33%	4
34-50.99%	6
51-67.99%	8
68-84.99%	10
85-100%	12

Application Evaluation Criteria: Scoring Methodology Part 2: Number

- Scoring Methodology Part 2: Placement in a normal distribution.
 - The program's placement in a normal distribution determines the points.

Sections I.1, I.2, and I.3

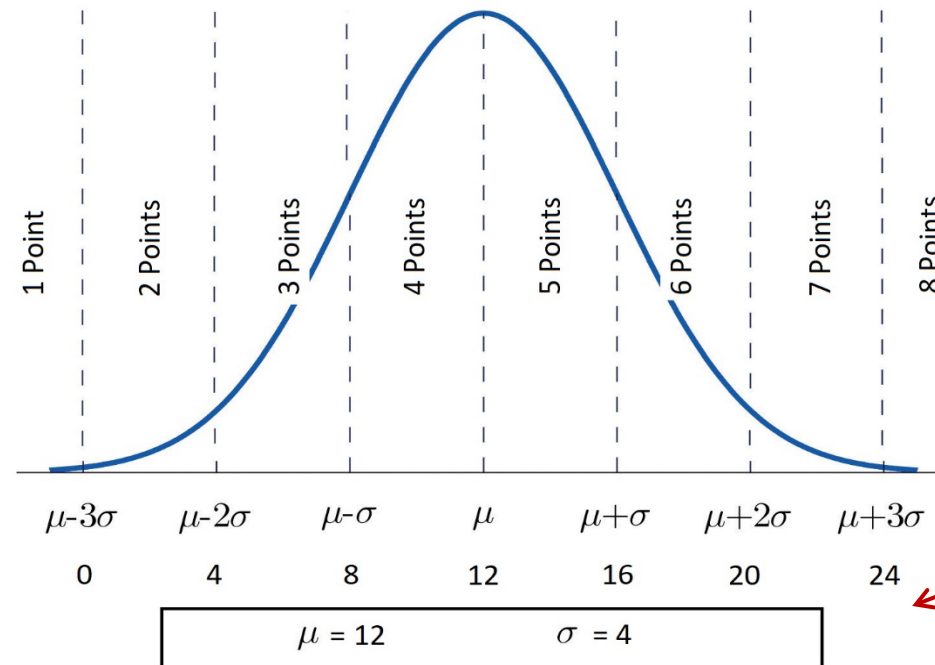
Number	Points
$\leq \mu - 3\sigma$	1
$> \mu - 3\sigma$ and $\leq \mu - 2\sigma$	2
$> \mu - 2\sigma$ and $\leq \mu - \sigma$	3
$> \mu - \sigma$ and $\leq \mu$	4
$> \mu$ and $\leq \mu + \sigma$	5
$> \mu + \sigma$ and $\leq \mu + 2\sigma$	6
$> \mu + 2\sigma$ and $\leq \mu + 3\sigma$	7
$> \mu + 3\sigma$	8

Section II.2

Number	Points
$\leq \mu - 3\sigma$	0
$> \mu - 3\sigma$ and $\leq \mu - 2\sigma$	1
$> \mu - 2\sigma$ and $\leq \mu - \sigma$	2
$> \mu - \sigma$ and $\leq \mu$	3
$> \mu$ and $\leq \mu + \sigma$	4
$> \mu + \sigma$ and $\leq \mu + 2\sigma$	5
$> \mu + 2\sigma$	6

Application Evaluation Criteria: Scoring Methodology Part 2: Example

- Program X Example
 - Program X has 15 percent underrepresented minority graduates.
 - According to the curve, the program will receive five points.

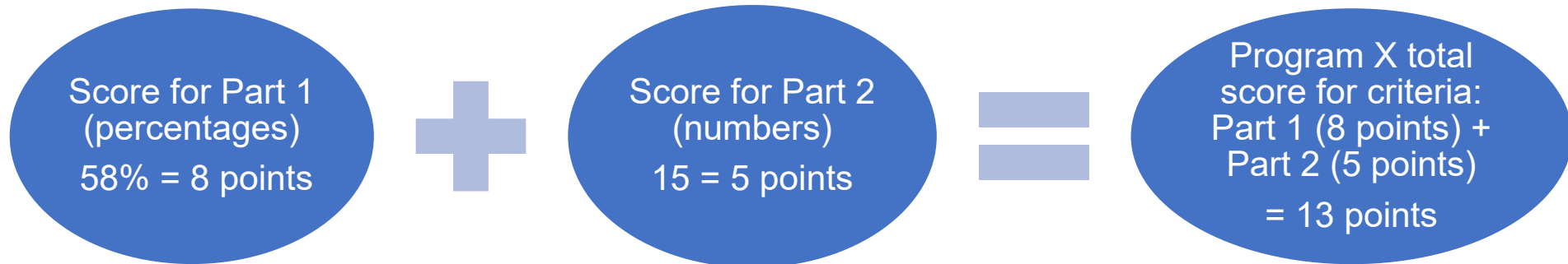


The bell curve is an example. Numbers change each cycle depending on applicants

Application Evaluation Criteria: Scoring Methodology Total Score

- Scoring Methodology Total Score: Combined Scores of Part 1 and Part 2.
 - After Part 1 and Part 2 are determined, the score is combined for the applicant's total score.
 - For example, Program X received 8 points for Part 1 and 5 points for Part 2, the program will receive a score of 13 points.
