

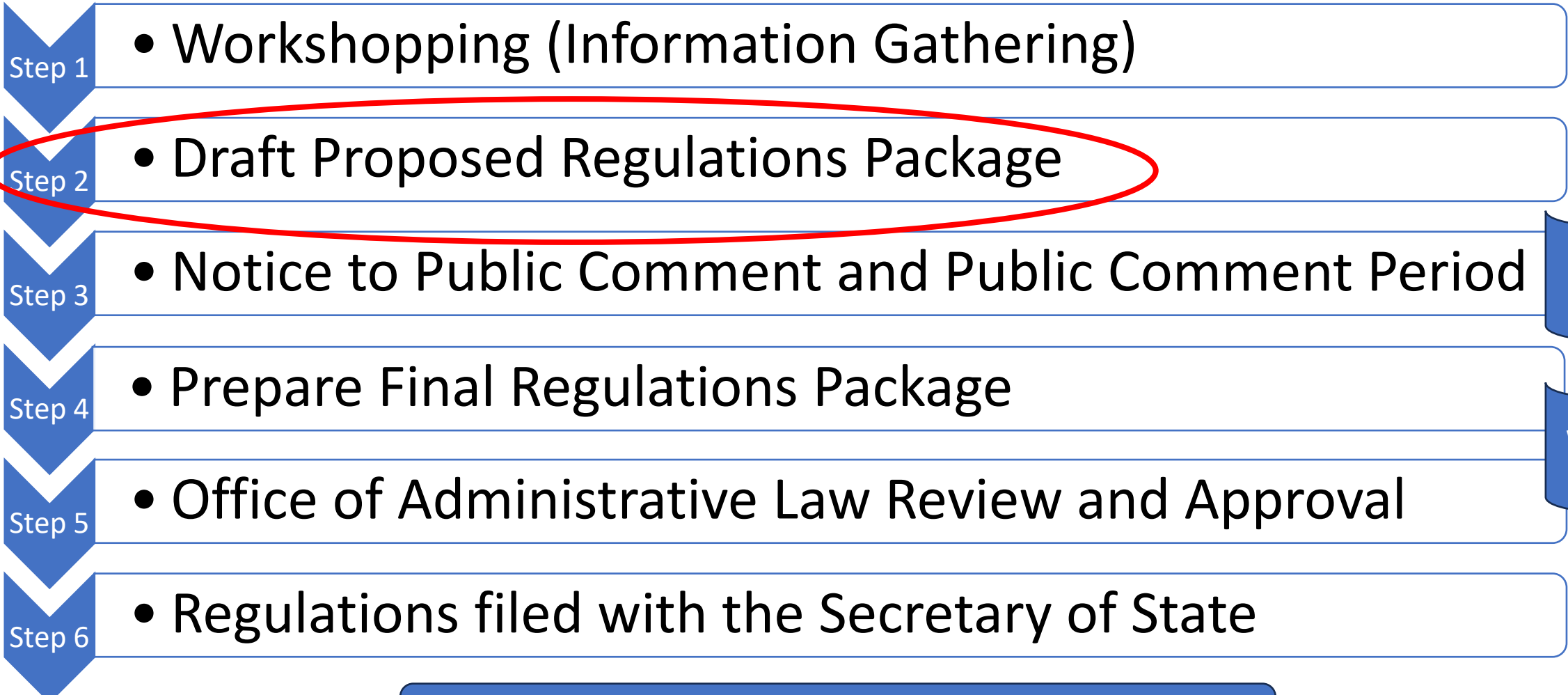

Stratification Requirements

- Assembly Bill 1204 requires a hospital equity report to include each measure broken down by each stratification category below, to the extent the data is available:
 - (a) Race / Ethnicity
 - (b) Age
 - (c) Sex Assigned at Birth
 - (d) Expected Payer
 - (e) Preferred Language
 - (f) Disability
 - (g) Gender Identity
 - (h) Sexual Orientation
- HCAI also added a "Behavioral Health Stratification" for readmissions as a required core quality measure.

OMB Race/Ethnicity Category Update – March 28, 2024

Statistical Policy Directive 15 Key Revisions:

- Combined question for race and ethnicity
- Encourages making selection of multiple options as they apply
- Adds Middle Eastern or North African (MENA) as a separate category – in 1997 version grouped under “White”
- Requires collection of additional detail for most situations to ensure further disaggregation when useful and appropriate.

What is your race and/or ethnicity?

Select all that apply and enter additional details in the spaces below.

American Indian or Alaska Native – Enter, for example, Navajo Nation, Blackfeet Tribe of the Blackfeet Indian Reservation of Montana, Native Village of Barrow Inupiat Traditional Government, Nome Eskimo Community, Aztec, Maya, etc.

Asian – Provide details below.

- Chinese Asian Indian Filipino
 Vietnamese Korean Japanese

Enter, for example, Pakistani, Hmong, Afghan, etc.

Black or African American – Provide details below.

- African American Jamaican Haitian
 Nigerian Ethiopian Somali

Enter, for example, Trinidadian and Tobagonian, Ghanaian, Congolese, etc.

White – Provide details below.

- English German Irish
 Italian Polish Scottish

Enter, for example, French, Swedish, Norwegian, etc.

Currently in draft regulations – based primarily on OMB 1997 Standards for Race/ Ethnicity
