Title 22, California Code of Regulations (CCR), Section 97437

Section 100 CHANGES WITHOUT REGULATORY EFFECT

Pursuant to Title 1, Division 1, Chapter 1, Article 2, Section 100(a), of the CCR, the Department of Health Care Access and Information, the Office of Health Care Affordability (OHCA) submits this written statement explaining why the proposed amendments to section 97437 of Article 1, Chapter 11.5, Division 7, of Title 22, CCR, do not materially alter any requirement, right, responsibility, condition, prescription, or other regulatory element of any CCR provision.

Subject to the approval of the Office of Administrative Law, OHCA would:

Renumber Title 22, section 97437 of the CCR as new section 97432 in the same Title, Division, Chapter, and Article.

OHCA requests to relocate and renumber section 97437 as section 97432. The change would move information regarding “Pre-Filing Questions” earlier in the Article to a new section. The change does not materially alter any requirement, right, responsibility, condition, prescription or other regulatory element. (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 1, § 100, subd. (a)(1).)
