Public Engagement

Thank you to all that completed our marketing survey last month! Your continued input is essential in the development of this role. Below are areas for stakeholder engagement that will be included in future newsletters later this year and early next year.

- a. **Technical Assistance**: We are developing a technical assistance resource center as a central guidance and resource hub for potential applicants and employers. These will highlight how to get trained as a Coach and how to hire and utilize Coaches once they're trained. We are looking to connect with our stakeholder partners across all sectors to provide guidance on what resources they need in order to integrate Coaches into their organizations.
- b. **Certification Renewal:** Our Wellness Coaches will need to recertify every two years. In early 2024 we will begin connecting with our stakeholders to gather input as we develop the renewal process.
