View shared documents, presentations, and whiteboards in the content viewer Participate in a chat to the host for technical issues View live video that the presenter sends "Raise Hand" during public comment; will be unmuted by the host to provide their public comment. Cannot Unmute themselves Cannot use video

When you join the meeting, please use your <u>unique panelist link</u> specifically assigned to you via email by OSHPD ISD ITSD. Each panelist link is unique to each individual and cannot be used by other members of the committee.






9. On the page that appears, click **Run a temporary application**:

- To restart your video, click **Start video**




7. How to Raise Your Hand in the WebEx Live Meeting

You can use the feature in two ways:

Option 1:

- 1. Find **your** name on the participant list, and hover over **your** name. A **Raise Hand icon** will appear.
- 2. Click on the **Raise Hand button** which will place a small hand icon next to your name in the participant list.
- 3. To turn the raise hand off, find **your** name on the participant list, hover over **your** name, and select **Lower Hand** on the Participants panel.



Option 2:

1. At the bottom of the participants panel, you will see a button to "raise hand". Click the box to raise your hand.2. To lower your hand, click the button again at the bottom of the participants panel.

Option 3: Phone Lines Only

If you are joining the meeting via phone, you may raise your hand or lower your hand by selecting *** 3**.

- When you hear a double beep, you are unmuted by the host.
- When you hear a single beep, the host has muted you.

8. How to Adjust the Panelist View/Screen Layout

You can change the screen layouts that you use in the Cisco WebEx Meetings in three views: Single, Overlay, and Grid. The participants videos are ordered by host, presenter, most recent speaker, participants sending video and then alphabetically.

Click on the upper right-hand corner of your screen to select your panelist view:

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
Option 1: Single View - Displays a full-screen video of the speaker
