REPORT PAGE 3 – PATIENT DEMOGRAPHICS

RACE AND ETHNICITY

This table is a patient count for race and ethnicity organized in a matrix format. This is a new table to the 2021 Annual Utilization Report of Primary Care Clinics. This table combines previously separated Race table and Ethnicity table as a combined single report table to better capture patient’s race and ethnicity from clinics. The race categories are on the vertical axis and the ethnicity categories are on the horizontal axis.
