## Background and Mission

AHSP is funded through grants, donations, and special funds. In exchange for a 12-month service obligation practicing and providing direct patient care in an underserved community, eligible applicants in a non-behavioral health profession may receive up to \$15,000 and applicants in an approved behavioral health profession up to \$25,000. Exception: Certified Nursing Assistants may also receive up to \$25,000. The purpose of this program is to increase the number of appropriately trained allied professionals providing direct patient care in an underserved area or qualified facility within California.

## Award Amount

The maximum award amount for the Allied Healthcare Scholarship Program (AHSP) is \$15,000 for non-behavioral health professions and \$25,000 for approved behavioral health professions. **Exception: Certified Nursing Assistants may also receive up to \$25,000.** HCAI may award full, partial, or no funding to an applicant based on the applicant's success in meeting the selection criteria, and the amount of available funds. Applicants will not be awarded more than their total cost of attendance for one year of the program.
