Example Existing Behavioral Health Measures

- Plan, State level (NCQA, Medicaid)
 - Follow-Up After Hospitalization for Mental Illness
 - Follow Up After Emergency Department Visit for Mental Illness
- Inpatient psychiatric hospitals (IPRQR)
 - To be discussed today
- Clinic level (SAMHSA, AHRQ)
 - Time to initial evaluation
 - Documentation of current medications in medical record
 - Screening for clinical depression and follow-up plan

No standardized, commonly reported behavioral health quality measures for hospitals




Managed Care Organization
